Despite recent technological, economical and industrial growth and the improvement of quality of life, the poverty rate remains as high as 39% and unemployment rate of 4.7% which leads to a great number of people struggling to meet ends meet in their daily lives. Even in large urban centers of the nation, much of the populace live below poverty line. Further exacerbated by the large income gap between demographic segments, rising inflation and rapidly depleting food and water resources, survival has become a despairing trial for a great number of people.

However, in the darkest of nights, there is an opportunity for the greatest light to shine. The Great and Almighty Creator has intricate plans, and He is the sole Sustainer & hope for all of his creations. We hope to cultivate dreams, passion, and empathy and develop an emotional connection across social boundaries. “Towards the Ocean of Success!”

In recent years Pakistan has observed an alarming decline in the per capita availability of water, reaching perilously close to the scarcity threshold of 1,000 cubic meters per annum. Coupled by the lack of resources and infrastructure, to this day much of the tribal and rural settlements all over the nation remain deprived of water, especially clean sources of drinkable water. A disconcerting amount of these settlements do not have electricity available as well, hence making the provision of water a much greater challenge.

Yet, it is in times of great distress that the hearts of the people unite, culminating the spirit of empathy to the fullest. As one of the most charitable nations, the people of Pakistan spare no efforts to come to the aid of the distressed in their greatest hours of need. Carrying on the legacy and in the spirit of national duty, Syed Zamir Jafri Foundation and Charity Doings Foundation, in their mutual collaboration, have worked together to play their part towards paving the future and towards the realization of a dream availability of clean drinking water for all!

With the combined efforts and great zeal showed by the organizations, more than 70 water projects have been successfully installed and are in operation over the nation, in rural areas of Punjab, Sindh and KP provinces. These range from solar operated water turbines to hand pumps, empowering the disheartened locals and enabling them the access to clean drinkable water.

Groundwater extraction remains the most optimum solution in order to provide access to clean water in remote areas, which is the underlying objective of these projects.

Furthermore, most of our water extraction projects make use of solar energy source, partially due to unavailability of grid electricity in most of these areas but also to honor the commitment towards the utilization of clean sources of electricity in order to minimize the carbon footprint to the greatest extent. Making use of the advantage of abundant solar irradiation, this energy source is greatly suitable for meeting the required objectives of sustainable development. The scope of these projects include complete lifetime maintenance of the infrastructure as well, ensuring long term commitment towards the cause.

The future objective of both organizations is to expand the coverage of the water provision projects over the nation, and galvanizing the spirit of charity of the nation to encourage the masses to board the ship of this noble cause. Each drop of our individual contributions & efforts will surely one day grow into a vast ocean! The essence of life, Paani water is the crux of national development

One of the many hurdles towards the socio-economic development of Pakistan is the vast segment of unemployed population, greatly curbing the GDP growth and national economy. Unemployed population in Pakistan is listed to exceed 46 Million (24.3% of total population), and is projected to increase in result to the COVID-19 pandemic outbreak. Lack of suitable employment opportunities and education have indeed escalated the conflict, leading towards alarming levels of unemployment nationwide, causing high dependency of this population segment on social welfare projects and government aid.

While welfare & relief projects are necessary for the partial alleviation of the immediate crisis, the crux of the problem lies in the potential of a vast segment of society being unutilized and geared towards the development of the nation. Empowerment in terms of capacity building and provision of suitable livelihood opportunities which cater to the needs of the people on individual basis, complementing their skills is the key towards the sustainable future development and eventual improvement in the socio-economic class of the unemployed population segment.

The aim of the sustainable livelihood projects implemented by Charity Doings Foundation is to empower the masses, enabling them to become self-dependent and able fulfill their physiological needs. The project basis is the recognition of key marketable skills, and providing suitable prospects of sustainable income in order to utilize those key strengths into an advantage. Under this ideology, diverse projects including but not limited to provision of vendor carts for income through selling street food, provision of vehicles (motorcycle, car, rickshaw etc.) for earning through transportation services and provision of key marketable setups for skilled work like sewing machines, are being implemented with great success, contributing towards the enlightenment and empowerment of the nation.

Sustainable livelihood projects aim for the growth of the society in a way that does not compromise or hinder the growth in any other aspect. Although donation of alms for the poor and needy is a vital component of the Charity Doings profile and will continue to be so, the long term solution lies in empowerment and capacity building, uplifting the socio economic bottom line to a higher level, thus elevating the GDP per capita of the nation as a whole. As important as economic growth is for the nation, as it directly influences a number of other factors positively, another major benefit is the transformation of the societal values in the nation as a whole. Opportunity opens up the doors to empowerment, and Ba-Ikhtiyari - empowerment - engenders positivity, ultimately uplifting the societal norms and mindset of the nation to create a better future.

PROJECT SHAJARKAARI



“SEEDS OF HOPE!”

“He who plants a tree, plants hope.” (Lucy Larcom) With increasing concerns about climate change and global warming, the global challenges of this era are unprecedented and have to be addressed with careful deliberation and policy planning. Pakistan as a nation not only faces this global threat, but also address its policies as a developing country heavily reliant on fossil fuels for its energy production, which exceeds 58% of its total energy mix. This has led to severe consequences in terms of environmental impact and heavy carbon footprint, leading the nation into a spiral of unsustainable and costly growth trend.

The Environmental Performance Index (EPI) rates Pakistan among the very last in air quality, with the average Air Quality Index (AQI) being 153 in 2020. The PM2.5 concentration in air for Pakistan is 11.8 times higher than the standard WHO annual air quality guideline value. In Lahore, the most polluted city in Pakistan has an AQI reaching as high as 163, depicting signs of alarming crisis and concerns with increasing health issues.

Charity Doings Foundation, driven by the philosophy of chasing a secure future for our next generations, has implemented the tree plantation drives projects, with the aim of developing large swathes of barrens into lush and meandering plains. With numerical target driven projects at different location throughout the country, especially Punjab and Sindh, Charity Doings Foundation aims to alleviate the great imbalance in environmental sustainability. Of the many plantation projects, one of the most significant was in Umerkot, Sindh with up to 5 acres of forestation completed with the plantation of various species of trees, including lemon, pomegranate, drumstick, gum Arabic and Neem plants. Through the plantation drives of more than a 1000 trees at a time, it serves as a much needed investment for the future generations. Trees serve as the natural guardians and the pillars of balance in nature, even more so in this era of fast paced technological advances uncaring of future consequences. In order to restore the balance to the agitated environmental balance, tree plantation has become a crucial investment for our future. As important as the act is in itself, it is the ideology behind the project that contains a much greater message to the nation. The seed, represents the sacrifice – a commitment to face challenges and seek for the light in despairing darkness. The untiring efforts of this nation are the soil, water and sunshine – allowing the seed to culminate into hope for our future. In order to alleviate the socio-economic crisis in Pakistan & improving the living standards and quality of life for the common populace, social empowerment and social welfare are the two sides of the same coins the former based on the ideology of a long term commitment to growth while the latter focusing on providing urgent relief to the needy and the poor. While the provision of sustainable livelihood opportunities is geared towards addressing the problem using the first approach, Charity Doings Foundation has also implemented the rations distribution projects in order to provide relief and comfort for the deserving section of the society, with the aim of alleviating their immediate crisis and providing them with economic means for survival. In light of the nation unemployment statistics discussed in detail in the previous section, it can be concluded that a vast segment of the society is dependent in terms of means of sustenance. While governmental and non-profit relief efforts for improving the society as a whole in the long term is crucial, equal investment, if not more, is required for addressing the immediate problem the provision of resources to those who cannot afford.

Charity Doings Foundation has worked towards promoting the values of empathy and social responsibility to the nation through this project, and has distributed household necessities on monthly basis to more than 1500 rations over the year. In future, project expansion in terms of scope and greater geographical coverage in the nation is planned, in order to effectively work towards the goal of providing relief to the deserving and needy. The project is the embodiment of the core tenets of social welfare in its purest sense, incorporating our societal ethical values as well as the teachings of Islam. Carrying the flame of empathy to the despairing, bringing warmth to their lives even if momentary, is the legacy we have inherited. We are a proud nation inspired by great charitable personalities, and the inspiration we achieve from their stories is the source of our actions. Charity Doings Foundations fully commit itself towards the dream of providing relief through Raashan -rations - to all those who require it, and greatly encourage the nation to join us in this endeavor

PROJECT KAFALAT



All of the misfortunes that fall upon a person, such as homelessness, poverty and hunger show even worse colors when they befall innocent children who are physically & mentally incapable of providing for themselves owing to their immaturity and gullibility. This is why helping orphans is of special importance in Islam. There are more than four million orphaned children in Pakistan, excluding the thousands that are not documented yet. These children, deserving of good care and education, are left homeless and helpless. The children that are supposed to be our future cannot imagine a good one for themselves.

Charity Doings finds it imperative and of the utmost importance that we extend our help to orphans. Undertaking this task, we launched Project Kafalat. Under the domain of this project, we are sponsoring an orphanage for girls in H-13. The objectives of this sponsorship are not limited to food and clothing, but to the entire living expense of every girl in the orphanage. This includes food, water, utilities, clothing, education (both the Quran and regular schooling), healthcare and security. The purpose of the project is to enable the physical, mental, emotional and spiritual well-being of these orphan girls by removing monetary hindrances. Project Kafalat has enabled us to provide a source through which donors can contribute towards better lives and better futures for these orphan girls.

Project Kafalat has recently undertaken the development of the orphanage as well, so that the children can have facilities like Air Conditioners, heaters, and, most recently, an outdoor gym. The aim is not just to provide basic necessities but also to provide a good quality of life, so that the girls may live in a safe and happy environment, receive the same opportunities as other children, and feel loved and cared for.

Contributions to Project Kafalat ensure that orphaned girls are receiving education and are being given the chance to learn and grow into strong independent women with enough educational fidelity to get them jobs. These girls are being saved from the usual fates of orphaned children which include child labor, abuse & poverty. It is an opportunity instead for them to grow up safely and happily, with the required facilities and care. The status quo for orphaned children usually includes adoption, but the problem with that is the unreliability of the new guardians of the child. They might not provide the ideal love and care we want for these children, and the children could be at a risk for abuse. Most often, they are just made to work as house workers and their education and personal growth neglected. By funding a well-established orphanage, we make sure that these problems are avoided.

The project is our attempt at aiding the provision of a well-facilitated and safe living environment to the unfortunate orphaned girls at H-13, enabling them to receive their education and have the same opportunities as other children to become good, resourceful and mindful members of the society. It is a way for us to uplift young girls and pave the path for them to become bright, self-serving women, improving not only their futures but the future of Pakistan as well.

PROJECT ROSHNI



“The day when we shall know what exactly electricity is, will chronicle an event probably greater, more important than any other recorded in the history of the human race. The time will come when the comfort, the very existence, perhaps, of man will depend upon that wonderful agent.” (Nikola Tesla)

Pakistan faces one of the greatest challenges in electricity provision. In this era of fast paced technological advancement and industrialization, the lack of developed infrastructure for electricity generation and distribution is a great liability and hurdle in the economic growth of the nation. While the electricity provision for industrial development is already a challenge, the situation is much worse in case of domestic electricity provision to the far reaching rural settlements. Pakistan is currently faced with an energy crisis of great threat, due to the rising costs of fuel, development of infrastructure, and decrease in output of hydroelectric power stations as a result of the ever growing water crisis. The situation is further exacerbated by fact that more than 58% of the total power generation of the nation comes from fossil fuels, which are not only quickly depleting over time, but also damage the environment considerably due to alarmingly high carbon footprint. The 26% share of hydroelectric power generation is also likely to show decrease in near future due to no new development projects in this area as well as decreasing water levels in the key rivers on which the dams are located. Furthermore, due to lack of developmental budget for power infrastructure and unavailability of sufficient power, many rural settlements to this day do not have provision of electricity. The extreme temperatures range up to 50C° making livelihood for the local communities a despairing challenge. Thus, Charity Doings Foundation has initiated Project Roshni – Light – to cater this growing problem.

Project Roshni lies under the domain of “Basic Needs & Infrastructure” aiming for the provision of electricity to the deprived rural settlements throughout Pakistan in order to elevate living standard and ease the survival of those rural communities. The initiative brings not only hope – “Roshni” – for the rural communities where there is no provision of grid electricity, but the solution is also sustainable in order to remove the dependence on grid electricity of the nation, while conserving natural resources as well. Since the topography of Pakistan makes it so that abundant solar irradiation is available year round, the project utilizes this advantage in terms of implementing solar unit project for the generation of electricity for sustainable development. In addition to the goal of providing a source of clean source of electricity to improve the total quality of life, the project also aims to provide cost a cost-effective and suitable solution to cater to the needs of the local populace. With the nation already facing deeply ingrained challenges such as poverty, unemployment and energy crisis, such projects which are not dependent on energy especially taking into consideration the high fossil-fuel dependence of the nation’s energy mix are of paramount importance, & are the key towards the sustainable development of the nation and the goal of achieving total electricity provision to all sectors of the society. Through implementation of these projects, which are the reflection of the ideology of the organization, we are a step closer to lighting the whole nation, with the light of hope touching all corners. Lastly, the projects are aimed towards the uplifting of the social mindset for the entire nation, through realization of the importance of this precious resource


